Tuition and fees are payable in person at the Office of Student Services, online via CLASS or at the Garden City campus.

Checks and money orders should be made payable to Adelphi University. Payment may also be made by MasterCard, Visa or Discover.

Cash is NOT accepted at the Manhattan Center (no exceptions will be made). Cash payments are accepted at the Garden City campus.

Students are responsible for all charges regardless of billing. All payments will be applied to past due balances first.

Those who elect to take additional Garden City courses will be governed by the Garden City tuition and fee rates.

Financial Aid:

- The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) application can be found at www.FAFSA.gov.
- Adelphi University FAFSA school code is **002666**.
- For the 2017-2018 academic year, complete the 17/18 FAFSA using 2015 tax information.
- Beginning October 1 2017, you may file for the 2018-2019 academic year using 2016 tax information.

- Graduate students are eligible for Federal Unsubsidized Direct Loans (6.00% interest rate).
- A minimum of six (6) credits per semester is required in order to be eligible for Federal Direct Loans.
- Financial Aid does not directly cover the summer semester (if coursework is required). If you do have to take summer sessions, you are suggested to speak with the Office of Student Services in Manhattan or Student Financial Services in Garden City for information about summer financial aid.

Scholarships:

- All academic merit-based scholarships are awarded through the Office of Admissions upon acceptance to the University. If you meet the criteria for a University scholarship, an award letter will be provided to you. You may also speak with your respective academic department for scholarship information.

Dropping a course –

Any student dropping prior to the first day of classes will receive a credit for all tuition, less the mandatory non-refundable registration fee. Non-attendance in a course and/or non-payment for a course does not constitute an official drop. Students will be responsible for payment of all tuition and fees until an official withdrawal form is presented to Academic Services. Refunds are calculated according to the refund schedule printed below as of the date the drop is received.
