Apply now for this tuition-free graduate fellowship in NYC!

Students selected for this Sport-Based Youth Development Fellowship will earn a Master's degree from Adelphi University in Physical Education or Sport Management in two years, with all tuition costs covered (18 credits a year). SBYD Fellows will specialize in Sport-Based Youth Development as part of their Master's degree. Students will work part-time for an SBYD organization as part of the SBYD Fellowship, gaining valuable experience in the field of sport-based youth development.

Wellness in the Schools inspires healthy eating, environmental awareness and fitness as a way of life for kids in public schools. Through public/private partnerships, WITS develops and implements programs that provide healthy foods, healthy environments and opportunities for play to help kids learn and grow.



Play Rugby USA is a non-profit organization that uses the unique power of rugby to empower and inspire youth, primarily from underserved communities, to go forward and realize their true potential. Their mission is to create a better world through rugby.



Vita Sports Partners is an innovative intermediary to the SBYD sector. Vita hosts a collaborative office space (SBYD Hub) from which it delivers needs-based services designed to strengthen and scale SBYD organizations so they can increase and sustain their long-term impact on the communities they serve.



Kids in the Game provides opportunities to NYC's youth through sports, movement, and play. From school programs (recess, physical education, afterschool) to day camps and sports clinics, their programs emphasize developing fundamental skills, leadership qualities, and healthy habits.

A: SBYD Fellows will work during the school year at NYC schools and non-profit organizations, along with some SBYD Fellows working during the summer (if required by the organization).
